JSRHS Scholastic Art Award Winners

January 27, 2017—Weare, NH—Several works created by JSRHS students were recognized by The Scholastic Art Awards, which offers early regional and national recognition of creative young people and scholarship opportunities for graduating seniors. Award winning artists are selected by professional artists in the state who are experts in their creative field.

Two John Stark students, Molly Glover and Caleb Roush won the highest award given---the Gold Key in the Portfolio category. Portfolio entries consist of eight artworks that are evaluated for originality, technical skill, and personal vision. Students must also write an artist's statement about their body of work. Molly and Caleb's work will travel on for National judging in New York City.

Molly Glover also received a \$500 scholarship in the competition from the Coca-Cola Foundation of Northern New England for her Gold Key portfolio. Sophomore Alison Wright earned a \$100 scholarship for her charcoal drawing "Reach," one of 12 works chosen for Best in Show.
