

## JOHN STARK SCHOOL DISTRICT

Article 4 on the John Stark School District warrant was not passed by the voters on March 14, 2017. Article 5 read, *Shall the John Stark School District, if Warrant Article 4 is defeated, authorize the governing body to call one special meeting, at its option, to address Warrant Article 4 cost items only?*

Article 5 passed, giving the John Stark Teachers' Association and John Stark School Board the opportunity to renegotiate cost items for reconsideration by the voters. The new agreement reduces overall costs by \$53,145.00 over the three year contract.
